He has garnered many one-design championships, has survived the infamous 1977 Fastnet Race, and, of course, was a key player on board Courageous during Ted Turner's 1977 winning of the America's Cup.

Gary is a three-time All American Sailor and, in 1999, won the coveted Nathaniel G. Herreshoff Trophy - US Sailing's most prestigious award for contributions to the sport of sailing. Notable among his many supporting roles is his National Regatta Chairmanship of the Leukemia & Lymphoma Society's sailing program. He continues to sail his Etchells and is presently partnered in the campaign of "MUSTANG", one of the new NYYC Swan 42s.
